If you have an idea for an article, please give "The Sleuth" a call.

Sleuths everywhere agree that if we ask the right questions, we can solve the problems. So here is the question: What do Mary Ann Falk, Sammi and Kirby Joseph, Val Weber, Lois Gehres, Dave Thompson, Eleanor Souders, Jon and Nancy Rhoades, Michele and Mark McCleery, Cindy Duvall, Carol Taylor, Jan Mack, Shirley Jarvis, Jill Leatherman, Barb Showalter, Tonia and Mark Verville, Kyle and Christie Wendel, have in common? The solution: they all have taught in WoRM at the First United Methodist Church School.

The next question: Why would someone be willing to spend a month of Sundays trying to teach Bible stories and Christian beliefs to children ages 6 – 12 years?

When the sleuth posed that question to the teachers, he not only got the answers, he got answers loaded with passion and zeal. "I love teaching in the Chapel!" responded Lois Gehres. "We get to know the kids so well as we share the Bible stories." Lois went on to share the joy she felt during the *Doubting Thomas* lesson when she had the youngsters fall backward into the arms of a classmate and adult. Jon Rhoades had a similar reaction. "It's amazing how the children want to participate and how much they can absorb at a young age."

"By the end of the month, kids really know the verses and have grasped the concepts," is how Val Weber described her thoughts. Val, who has been teaching since the inception of WoRM five years ago, likes that depth of

understanding that the children gain in First Churches' **Workshop Rotational Model**. She, like the other teachers, is most rewarded when the lesson allows the students to actively interact with the Bible and to apply Christian principles to their own lives.

The sleuth knows that all you teachers - the ones this article names as well as those of you who are unnamed - know exactly what Jesus meant when he said, "Let the little children come unto me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these" (Mark 10:13-14). Teens and Parents and Everyone else,

Whaddup my Peeps! We have a lot going on this month. Can you believe it is Summer?...Yes...Summertime! This month we come to the biggest event of the year...**ICHTHUS!** In case you missed it there still might be time for you to get in on it. Ichthus is June 12-15th. What is Ichthus? Ichthus is an incredible 5 day 4 night event of primitive camping (tents, porta-potties, and no electric) that will change the way you look at God and they way you look at being a Christian. It is located in Wilmore, Kentucky. In this event there are concerts all day long of the best in Christian Music. The concerts start with worship each morning and finishing each evening. This does not give you the whole idea...there are also great speakers each day, as well as, some really interesting seminars for teenagers on what it is like to be a Christian. Still, this doesn't give you the whole picture. Ichthus is is about relationships, your relationship with your youth group but also with Christ. I first went to Ichthus when I was in High School but I also kept involved in it while I was in Seminary at Asbury Theological Seminary. (Asbury helped to start Ichthus years ago.) Check it out yourself on www.ichthusfestival.org . We will have a great time there and it will be something you will always remember.

HOW CAN I HELP WITH ICHTHUS?

If you're thinking you would like to help...read on...How can I help? Well, here are some ways: 1) In order for the kids to eat and have some shelter we have a big circus tent that we are renting to provide a place for us to meet and eat (this tent is 20x40 so it is huge) the cost to rent this tent for the week is \$325. It would be great if some/one of you would like to sponsor the kids and give towards this tent. Ask me if you would like to be a part of this ministry to the kids. 2) Another way is to help by providing some of the food/paper items that are needed. Check outside the sanctuary at either entrance/exit for the Ichthus tents and take a tag (each tag will have items on it take one, two etc.) then bring the item(s) back and give them to Jon. 3) Give a partial scholarship. (There are a few kids that have a hard time meeting the costs of trips and your gifts can help them go.) 4) Lastly, pray for us that God really moves and the kids are drawn into a closer relationship with him.

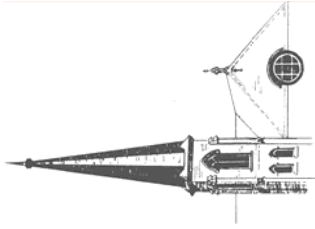

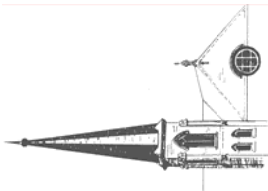
