Another opportunity for involvement is helping with Friday night 5th Quarter events after home VWHS football games on September 16 and October 14. We are also looking for mentors to work with 8th graders at VWMS once a week during the school day (30 minutes/week). I also want to highlight that in September the special offering goes to Church World Service's Blanket project. This project puts blankets in the hands of those who need them, all over the world. \$10 buys a blanket for a person in need. This is a monetary offering only.

And lastly, a mission impact report from Stand For Truth Ministries, Joel Penton, Jr.'s ministry that we support: Stand for Truth has 3 divisions. The Relevant Speakers Network and SFT Outreach did 335 school assemblies and 68 outreach concerts in 23 states last year. Lifewise Academies is growing like

a weed! In 2021, there were 8 schools in the program with 1,111 students enrolled. In 2022, there were 34 schools with 5,383 students enrolled. Next year, they are hoping for 100 enrolled schools!! Keep Stand For Truth and all our missionary partners in your prayers.
