



Lent begins February 22, and the Mission Committee is once again recommending preparing a Festival of Sharing Kit for @First Church Service Opportunities at First United Methodist Church a Lenten project. Festival of Sharing is a project of Church

World Service that we have participated in for years. There are 3 types of kits that we will be collecting. You can assemble a hygiene kit or a school kit at home. The lists of what goes into each kit are available at fosohio.org and will also be available at each church entrance. Homemade bags for the school kits will also be available at the church entrances. The third type of kit is an emergency cleanup bucket. If you are interested in just a financial donation, this is the kit for you! Because of storage logistics, we will collect monetary donations toward clean up buckets and the mission committee will put them together when it is time to drop them off. The cost of clean up buckets is estimated to be around \$75 each.

Thank you for your generous donations to our Christmas offering. \$11,000 was raised to be split between the three projects we had selected: Haven of Hope,  $H_2O$  Mentoring program and the Agape Fund. Thank you for helping make a difference to help people in our community.
